## MAJOR COMMITMENTS: Please read carefully.

1. WEEKLY ASSIGNMENTS: When you are scheduled to work, it is vitally important to be in your place and on time. If for any reason you will not be able to fulfill your commitment, it is your responsibility to call your LEAD of the week in advance and inform them.

2. SET UP AND CLEAN UP: Every volunteer who is involved in serving needs to arrive early (8:15/10:15 am) and stay after to help with the set up and clean up of the room. Occasionally when families have a need to leave quickly, they may arrange that with their LEAD.

3. TRAINING: In an effort to better prepare for ministry, Training sessions will be scheduled throughout the year. These Training Sessions are not optional.

- While serving in BRAVE Kids, phones should be put away, with EXCEPTION of communicating with parents or guardians briefly.

• If unable to cover scheduled assignment, be sure to let Early Childhood or Elementary Coordinator know a week in advance if possible.

• Engage with children by reading books, playing games, puzzles, coloring, sitting with them in Large Group and asking them questions, etc...

- Assist the teacher by sitting with children during the lesson and helping keep them focused.
- Assist by participating with worship time by demonstrating motions and singing with children.
- Assist children with activities as directed by the Lead Teacher
- Help with snack and clean up at end of class.
- Help children collect their belongings and crafts they made to prepare for parents or guardians to pick them up.
- Help by getting children ready and bring to Lead Teacher during dismissal.
- Be sure to attend other service.
