## Sermon Questions 1 Tim 6:12-21

This week we discussed how we need to fight the good fight of faith. Before we are saved we are in a spiritual battle with the devil but have yet to realize that fact. Once we are saved, we learn that the devil, the world and our sinful selves attempt to limit us from God's best. The Scriptures teach that when we are on mission for Him that we are the most satisfied and He is the most glorified. We live in a world that is hostile to Jesus Christ, churches that are complacent and apathetic, and countless souls that need to hear and see a demonstration of the Spirit of God in power. As Paul concludes His letter to Timothy, he provides four commands that are essential to allow the church to bring the greatest glory to the Lord. As you listen to the message and read the study questions, consider what application the Lord wants you to make from His Word today.

Here are some notes to review from this week's sermon...

Fight the Good Fight 1 Timothy 6:12-21

Fight for the faith until Christ comes (12-15a)

Honor God only and always (15b-16)

Focus on God and good works (17-19)

Guard the glory of the gospel with your life (20-21)

## **Questions**

- 1. What does it mean to fight the good fight? How are we called to fight? How do you know we are in a battle? What is the battle we are in? Who is our enemy? When should we stop fighting?
- 2. What are some of the Scriptures that discuss warfare? Why must we understand that the church is the Army of the Lord? How should we armor up for this battle? How is the fighting we do as Christian differ from the way the world fights?

- 3. What does it mean to take hold of the Eternal Life? Who is the Eternal Life? How do we take a greater hold of Jesus Christ? How can you personally experience more of Jesus Christ in your life? What changes do you need to make?
- 4. How does our world's system attempt to stop your mission for Christ? How does your flesh attempt to stop your mission for Christ? How does the devil attempt to stop your mission for Christ? How can we grow in our battle against these three forces?
- 5. Why is winning this battle so important? How many souls are on their way to a Christ-less eternity? How can the church make a difference?
- 6. Why are we to honor God only? Why are we to honor God always?
- 7. What is the sovereignty of God? How are we to honor God's sovereignty? Why is it easy to honor His sovereignty when we are blessed? Why is it difficult to honor God's sovereignty when go through trails and persecutions? Since God is both good and sovereign what should we pray when we are going through difficulties?
- 8. What is the immortality of God? Why is His eternality so essential? How should we honor the fact that He is the Life? Our life?
- 9. What is the holiness of God? How should we honor the Lord's holiness? Why do most people try to find life apart from Christ? What happens if they think they have discovered the life? Why can nothing apart from Christ truly be fulfilling?
- 10. How should we continue to focus on God? How should we continue to do good works? What are some of the good works we should be doing? Why are good works essential for a believer?
- 11. How does God bless generosity? Why does God bless generosity? How can you be more generous? How can you be more content? What happens when you are generous towards God?
- 12. How does God want to bless His children? What are some Scripture verses that you claim from God's Word that bless you? Why is it important to teach others what you have learned?
- 13. What does it mean to guard the gospel with your life? Would the gospel be worth dying for? Why does God want you to live without spot or wrinkle? Why is your testimony so important?
- 14. What has been your greatest take-a-way from the message? What is a specific application that the Lord wants you to make this week?
