Learn from the example of others. (6-11)

IDOLATRY: Giving ultimate worship to that which is not ultimate.

IMMORALITY: Living for pleasure and/or convenience.

TESTING GOD: Verbalizing frustration and distain with God's plan.

GRUMBLING: Specifically attacking or complaining about God-given authority.

In humility, continually pursue God's glory and His plan of escape. (12-13)
