Do you expect to experience God's grace and blessing ("a hundred fold") in this life and in the life to come? Do you need to leave anyone or anything behind to follow Jesus and experience this blessing?

Provides us with opportunities to serve.

What does the parable of the laborers teach you? How can you apply that lesson/principle to your life?

Is serving a burden or a blessing to you? Why?

Jesus placed His people on this earth to serve people (i.e. Matthew 28:19-20 and Matthew 22:37-40). Are you willing to serve and carry out the task Christ assigned to His church? If you serve and you see others who aren't, what is your reaction? What does that reflect about your motivation for serving?

Allows everyone the privilege of experiencing the full benefits of salvation.

Why is it that there are no first or second class citizens in heaven?

Are there areas of sin in your life where you are not sure if God's grace is sufficient to redeem it and where you are believing you may miss out on experiencing the full benefits of salvation?

Accountability Questions:

What is holding you back from following Jesus and accomplishing the task He asked each one of us in His church to accomplish? How can you forsake the world and your flesh to follow Jesus?

The Gospel is offered to everyone and saves anyone who accepts it no matter what they have done. If you have never trusted Christ and committed your life to Him, what is holding you back? If you sense the need to recommit your life to Christ, what is stopping you from doing that now?

How can you be held accountable while holding others in your group accountable to follow after Jesus?
